# **2017 Oregon Flock and Fiber Festival Pygora Goat Show**

Lisa Roskopf judged the Pygora goat show and Ruth Hawkins served as her judge's apprentice. The show was well attended with 55 Pygoras, nine junior bucks, 11 wethers and 35 does, entered to be shown on Sunday September 24. The show was held in a show ring under a tent and we were all thankful for cooler temperatures and sunshine the day of the show. Misty Harding was the show chair, Debbie Eubanks was ring steward, and Erica Brown was the show photographer.

As a founder of the Oregon Flock and Fiber Festival, Lisa Roskopf values the role of showing Pygora goats into the pubic awareness. As it was the 30th anniversary of the creation of the Pygora goat, it was a fitting choice for her to be our judge this year. Lisa has focused her skills on 4-H youth, creating 4-H internships yearly at her ranch during spring break and being a resource 4-H leader.

At OFFF, we do not show senior bucks so do not have a sanctioned buck show, but we do show iunior bucks. The Champion Junior Buck was awarded to Hawks Mountain Ranch Arrowhead Chocolate bred by Lisa Roskopf and owned by Kari Schroeder and the Reserve Champion Junior Buck is Quail Hollow Farm Dominic Toretto bred by Allison Brown and owned by Kari Schroeder.

The Grand Champion Wether was Crickview Ranch Coco bred by Kari Schroeder and owned by Deborah Christensen and Marissa Liao. The Reserve Grand Champion Wether was awarded to Trillium Valley Farm Pez bred and owned by Janet Tilp.

The Grand Champion Doe was Crickview Ranch Journey bred and owned by Kari Schroeder and the Reserve Grand Champion Doe was Sundance Stella bred and owned by Abigail Lewis.

There were special awards giving this year in addition to ribbons: Grand Champion Doe and Grand Champion Wether each receive a \$50 prize courtesy of the NW Pygora Club. The best fleece on a wether received the Sally McCarrick Memorial Award of \$50, sponsored by the Wild Goat Women. Reserve Grand Champion Doe received a 30th Anniversary PBA Duffle Bag, courtesy of Quail Hollow Farm Pygora Goats. Thank you Wild Goat Women, the NW Pygora Club and Quail Hollow Farm for your sponsorship and generosity.

The Annual Fisher Schroeder Memorial Award, which is given in memory of Fisher Schroeder, Kari's son, who tragically was killed in a car accident in March 2015, to the overall Champion youth showman, who embodies the most knowledge and grace showing their Pygora Goat. This award is a poignant moment for all who attend and all who had the joy of knowing Fisher. Tears are still shed. This year the three first place showman competed for the award, Nadia Belov, Sophie Kunka, and Allison Brown. For 2017, the winner of the Fisher Schroeder Memorial Award was Nadia Belov. Our hope is that our youth continue with their projects, and then become adults who continue to be involved with Pygora goats and fiber.

It was great to see so many new exhibitors this year! Thank you Cowlitz River Caprines, Sundance Pygoras, Sophie Kunka, Synove Hansen, and Yaks in the Cradle for your first show and participation! We all look forward to seeing you again next year.

## **2017 Oregon Flock & Fiber Festival Pygora Fleece Show**

The 2017 Oregon Flock and Fiber Festival celebrated the 30th Anniversary of the creation of the Pygora Goat by making them the featured breed. OFFF featured a lot of activities surrounding our beloved Pygora Goats and their fiber including a Pie and Ice Cream Social and Spin-In, a fleece show, a class about the ABC's of Pygora fiber taught by Terry Mattison, an obstacle course and the Pygora goat show. PBA President, Ruth Hawkins, who visited from Kansas, and PBA Vice President, Debbie Eubanks, from Iowa, attended OFFF.

Friday evening the Northwest Pygora Club sponsored a Pie and Ice Cream Social and Spin-In which was very well attended. The Spin-In gave club members an opportunity to share their knowledge and demonstrate spinning the lovely fiber provided by the Pygora goats. Thank you Julie Case and Lisa Roskopf for your amazing attention to detail and creating a welcoming gathering and to all the Northwest Pygora Club members who donated pies, ice cream, cash and their time to this event.

On Saturday morning, the Autumn Pygora Fleece show commenced. The judge this year was George DeGeer of Hawks Mountain Ranch from Gaston, Oregon. There were 29 fleeces entered in the show and every Pygora fiber type was represented! Mr. DeGeer shared a running commentary on his evaluations of the fleeces as he judged.

In addition to the ribbons awarded the following special awards were presented: A prize of \$25 sponsored by the NW Pygora Club was awarded to the Grand Champion Fleece. A 30th Anniversary Pygora Breeders Association large duffle bag was awarded to the Reserve Grand Champion Fleece. The best wether fleece received the Sally McCarrick Memorial Award of \$25, sponsored by the Wild Goat Women. Thank you to all of our generous sponsors of the Pygora Fleece Show.

This year we showcased a few fun classes for the fiber show, Unbred Does, who are does over the age of two years old that have not birthed live kids. These classes are not included as part of the sanction but is a showcase for these animals to show their fiber. We had two entries, one entered in the unbred doe age 2-3 years old class, Tasteful Farms Tangerine bred and owned by Robert Harding and the second doe in the Unbred Doe over 3 years old class, HMS Sobe, bred and owned by Sydney Liao. HMS Sobe won Champion Unbred Doe and Tasteful Farms Tangerine was awarded Reserve Champion Unbred Doe.

One of the unique things about the fleece show is an exhibitor can compete in the show even if they are not present. Mailing a fleece in to the show is a relatively easy and the feedback is educational,

The Northwest Pygora Club also had a display case of natural Pygora fiber and Pygora blends and finished projects to educate the public to the uses of Pygora fiber. It was a great success and the display was stunning. Thank you Connie Williams and Jerri Hansen for putting the display together! We also had the PBA display board up, thank you Kari Schroeder for making it, and one 4-H Pygora poster on display.

On Saturday afternoon, Julie Case and Lisa Roskopf created a spooky and haunted goat obstacle course that was well attended by both goats and spectators. It is always a crowd favorite! Lisa and Julie recycle ribbons and create the most beautiful awards for this event.
